Membership benefits

HCDO County selection via two different formats:
1. Team league
2. Singles league
 Both played on the same Friday night

Free individual **MAD** membership paid by the superleague (non-transferable if players are already members).
 No team or league **MAD** membership fee.

Free entry to £500 prize money competition during team and player registration night. This sign on night will be a **MAD** event so players can earn **MAD** ranking points.

Join a **MAD** affiliated team and league qualifying for regional and national teams and events.
 Join a **MAD** affiliated singles league earning **MAD** event ranking points each night.

1: Team league: Teams and players can qualify for MAD super-regional and national finals.
 Teams and players can qualify for **UKDA** Super cup, national singles and pairs.

2: Eastleigh darts series (EDS) singles league.
 Players can earn **MAD** ranking points each night, qualifying for **MAD** major competitions.
 Open to Men and Ladies.

The EDS singles league is open to all non HCDO men and ladies superleague members that are MAD individual members at normal weekly entry cost. Players do not have to play in both league formats but must be at least signed up to a superleague team (format 1) and pay full membership to achieve the full benefits and county selection.

Format 1: HCDO Eastleigh superleague team league

(7.45pm start – 9pm) each fixture

Team League Format:

- 8 players per team.
- Format is 8 v 8 single matches, best of 7 legs, 501.
- Depending on number of teams (maximum 8 teams): Each fixture played over 4 boards or 8 boards (champions cup style).
- Team league will have fixtures on 14/15 nights in total (depending on number of teams) plus separate nights for UKDA national singles and pairs county playoffs.
- Team winners of the league will qualify for UKDA national finals super cup.
- MAD individuals points gained during the league format are accumulated by the number of 177/180 scores and checkouts of 60+. MAD points are not based on averages; averages will be used for county selection.
- During each night, team captains are responsible for team selection, draws, timely start, the collection and data entry of stats for MAD and football card sales on designated weeks.
- Annually, the best team in the MAD region will qualify for the MAD super-regional team finals.
- Three times a year the top individual MAD ranked 12 men, 6 ladies, 3 youths (18-21 yrs), and 3 seniors (over 64yrs) based on MAD league performances qualifies for the regional team at the super-regional finals. Performance at these super-regional finals will determine the super-regional team at the national championships.
- UKDA national singles and pairs county qualifier is open to all members of this league.

Team fees

- No team registration fee – but all players must be members (£15 player registration fee).
- £16 team fee per fixture (£2 per player per match with a full team).

Prize money (based on 8 teams and 100 members)

Teams to play each other twice over 14 nights of competition (8 teams).

Teams to play each other three times over 15 nights of competition (6 teams).

An extra night will be used for UKDA national singles and pairs playoffs.

Team and player sign on night - MAD ranked!

Date: Friday 2nd July 2021 – (doors open 6.30pm, sign up by 8pm)

- If you are interested in putting a team into the league please contact Mike Gillet, there is a maximum of 8 teams so that the singles series league can take place the same evening.
- Teams from Portsmouth, Romsey, Basingstoke and Eastleigh have already confirmed – 4 team spaces left.
- There is no cost to register a team into the league (all MAD team and league fees are free for UKDA registered superleagues). Just make sure you have atleast 8 players that can attend each fixture and to spread the team cost per fixture, and that each team has a team captain to organise the team.
- Teams can be registered into the league anytime from now up until and including the sign on night.
- If you do not have a team, please turn up during the sign on night and you can either join an existng team, or create a new team made up of other players without a team. All we will need in the later case is someone to elect themselves as captain for the new team. A facebook group has been set up for players looking for a team.
- The £15 player membership fee is payable at the start of the sign on night between 6.30pm – 8pm.
- The £500 guarenteed prize money sign on night competiton is open to all players that register during the sign on night at no extra cost. The approx start time is 8.30pm and will carry MAD ranking points.
- Players can become superleague members after the sign on night, the membership fee will remian at £15. The only member benefit lost from being a late member to the league is the opporunity to have entered and competed for the big money sign on night competiton.

Sign on night prize money breakdown

- Free entry and open to players that sign up and join a Men's superleague team during the sign on night.
- The sign on night competiton will carry MAD ranking points as part of the MAD events. All registered players will automatically become MAD indivual members as the super league will pay all members fees for this.
- £300 winner
- £100 runner up
- £50 each losing semi finalists
- Total prize money: £500
- MAD ranking points available: Winner 64 points, Runner-up 32 points, Last 4, 16 points, Last 8, 8 points, Last 16, 4 points.
- Darts connet will be used and these stats will be avaiable to HCDO to aid county selection.



Format 2: HCDO Eastleigh Dart Series (EDS) singles league

(9pm – 11.30pm) each fixture, register by 8.30pm

Singles League Format (Eastleigh Darts Series):

Open to all HCDO UKDA members and other MAD individual members (Men & Ladies).

- 18 events of single elimination knockout competition with a grand final for the top 24 players after 18 events.
- £6 entry fee per event.
- Best of 5 501 throughout. (If the event is completed well before 11.30pm the format may be increased to best of 7 for some / all rounds in future events).
- £100 winner prize guaranteed each event.
- MAD ranking points for each main event: Winner 32 points, R/up 16 points, Last 4, 8 points, Last 8, 4 points.
- MAD rankings determine qualification for a number of MAD “Majors” across the season.
- All members of HCDO paying £15 membership fee will automatically be registered as a MAD member.
- Separate £50 winner prize guaranteed ladies competition each event if there is a minimum of 8 ladies.
- Ladies MAD ranking points for each Ladies event: Winner 16 points, R/UP 8 points, Last 4, 4 points.
- If there are fewer than 8 Ladies then Ladies can play in the main competition.
- Top 24 players (based on performance over 18 events) qualify for the EDS grand finals.
- The EDS grand final will invite the top 20 Men and top 4 Ladies over 18 weeks of events.
- Darts connect used for all main competition games, meaning all players stats are recorded for Hampshire county selection. (Hampshire selection only applies to HCDO members that have paid the £15 member fee and are at least signed for a HCDO superleague team).
- This EDS singles league is open to all HCDO superleague members and other individual MAD members.
- Any PDC tour card holders can still play in these events if signed up to HCDO (£15 member fee), however will be unable to earn any MAD ranking points.

Weekly points system:

Main competition EDS points:

- Winner: 10 points
- Runner up – 8points
- Last 4 – 6 points
- Last 8 – 5 points
- Last 16 – 4 points
- Last 32 – 2 points
- Last 64 – 1 point

Ladies competition EDS points: (Separate ladies event only run when at least 8 Ladies are in attendance, otherwise ladies will play in the main competition)

- Winner – 6 points
- Runner up – 4 points
- Last 4 – 3 points
- Last 8 - 2 points
- Last 16 – 1 point

Ladies can only enter if they are a MAD individual member (£5 membership fee online at MAD)

Player weekly entry fees: £6 entry fee per player. (£4 goes to the league, £1 darts connect fee, £1 HCDO fee)

Weekly prize money

- £100 main winner
- £40 main runner-up
- £10 each semi finalists
- £50 ladies winner (subject to at least 8 entries)
- £10 ladies runner-up (subject to at least 8 entries)
- Total weekly prize money: £220 (subject to a separate ladies competition)

EDS Grand finals:

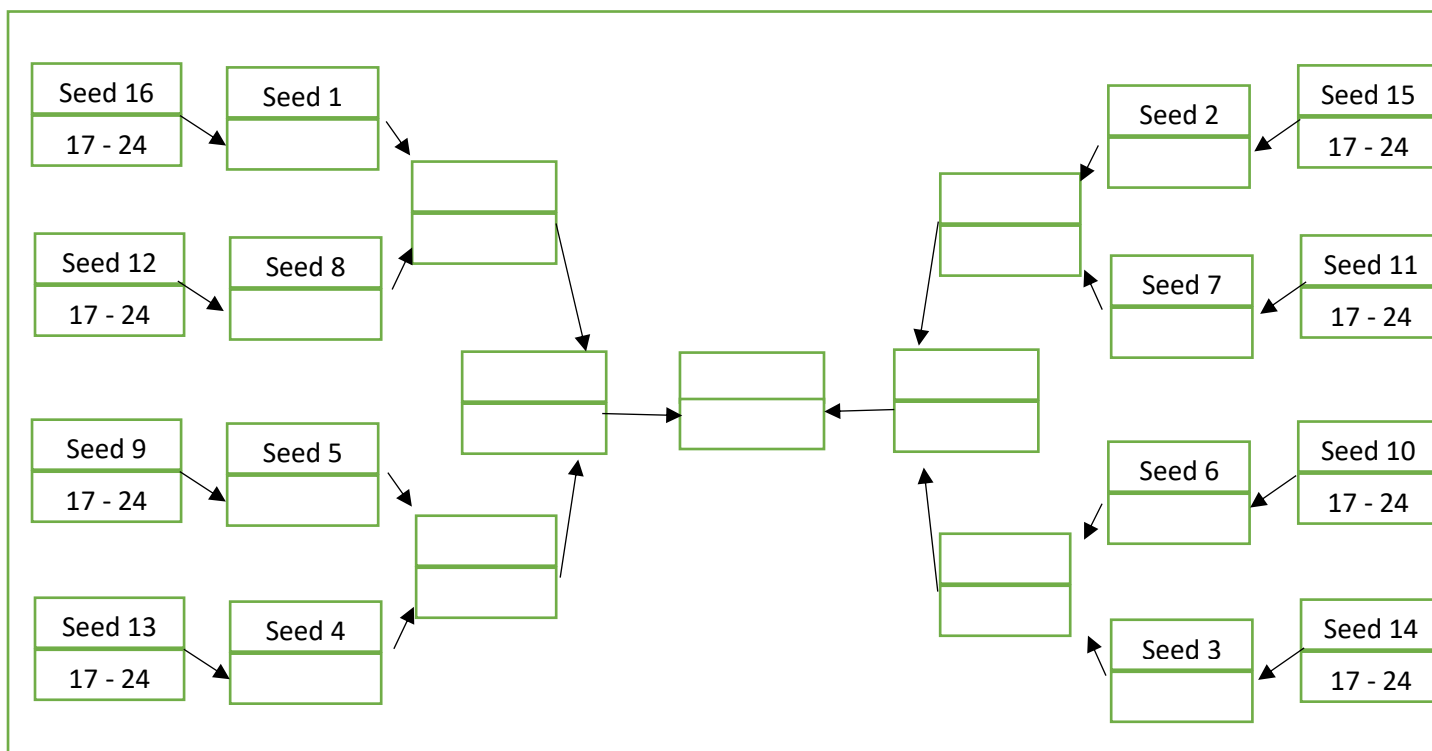
Top 24 players qualify for the grand finals. This includes the top 20 men and the top 4 ladies over 18 events.

The 24 players will be given a seeding related to their final position in the EDS rankings. (Seed 1 to 7 coming from the top 1 to 7 Men's EDS rankings after 18 events).

The 4 ladies players will automatically adapt the following seed positions:

- Top lady – Seed 8 (unless holding a higher ranking position in the main points table)
- Second best lady – Seed 15 (unless holding a higher ranking position in the main points table)
- Third and fourth best lady will be in seed pot 17 -24 (unless holding a higher ranking position)

The top 8 seeds will advance straight into the last 16. Seeds 9 to 16 will have a fixed position in the grand finals whilst seeds 17 to 24 will be drawn out randomly against seeds 9 to 16 to determine the first round of the grand finals as shown below:



Format for the grand finals:

- Last 24 – Best of 7 legs
- Last 16 – Best of 9 legs
- Last 8 – Best of 11 legs
- Last 4 – best of 13 legs
- Final – best of 15 legs.

Grand final plate competition: open to anyone that has played at least 1 week that does not make the top 16 in the grand final competition. Format will be 501 best of 5 throughout, money in money out.

Grand final prize money (subject to an average weekly entry of 45 players in the main comp)

- £500 winner
- £200 runner-up
- £100 each semi finalists
- £60 each quarter finalists
- £40 each last 16
- £20 each last 24
- Grand final prize money: £1 620

Grand final prize money (subject to an average weekly entry of 40 players in the main comp)

- £400 winner
- £200 runner-up
- £100 each semi finalists
- £50 each quarter finalists
- £25 each last 16
- £15 each last 24
- Grand final prize money: £1 320

Grand final prize money (subject to an average weekly entry of 32 players in the main comp)

- £300 winner
- £100 runner-up
- £60 each semi finalists
- £25 each quarter finalists
- £15 each last 16
- £10 each last 24
- Grand final prize money: £820

Please note: 1 x football cards will need to be sold each night during the event to help fund all prize money on offer.

Before the pandemic in 2020, we were averaging 42 players per night in last year's singles events.

HCDO Inter County funds

The whole superleague will raise approximately £800 over the season for HCDO county funds. £1 out of everyone's £6 entry fee during each week will contribute to this, plus £1 out of the £15 sign on fee goes to HCDO. These funds will pay for the increased associated costs in the county voting to join the UKDA where the county will represent. This allows both superleague formats to be affiliated with Hampshire County Darts and therefore provides players the chance to earn selection to the county team, as well as the numerous other benefits outlined in this document.
